

## FAQs for the Texas Legal App

### **Q. What is the Texas Legal App?**

A. The C&T Section Texas Legal App contains over 50 codes, rules and statutes in areas of Appellate, Bankruptcy, Business, Computer, Criminal, Family, Intellectual Property, Real Estate and more. Plus, there's free Google Scholar case law. You can also make “electronic notes” in every section of every statute, which you can use for later reference. And, you can email case law and portions of statutes to yourself, opposing counsel or even the judge in the courtroom.

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### **Q. I am a member of the C&T Section. Please create the authorization so I can use the App.**

A. You are already authorized to use the app. Our records show you are a member of the C&T Section and you have logged in at [sbot.org](http://sbot.org). If you have downloaded the app, it will ask for your username and password. Your username is your State Bar Number, and your password is the same one you use to log on to your MyBar page at [TexasBar.com](http://TexasBar.com), and to log in at [sbot.org](http://sbot.org). If you have forgotten your password, you can go to the forgot your password link on the MyBar page. If you have other problems logging on to the app, make sure you have listed your email address as your primary contact in your profile on your MyBar page.

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### **Q. I would like to have access to the free App.**

A. First, you must be a member of the Computer & Technology Section to access the App. If you are not a member, you can join with a credit card at your MyBar page at [TexasBar.com](http://TexasBar.com). Log in to your MyBar page using your state bar number as your username and a password of your own choosing. While you are at your MyBar page, be sure your email address is shown as your primary contact in your State Bar profile. Wait about 24 hours for your Section membership to take effect in the State Bar's records, then log in at [sbot.org](http://sbot.org) with the same username and password you used on the MyBar page. This will authenticate your membership for purposes of using the App. Then download the App from the App Store or the Google Play Store, depending on which platform you use. The first time you access the App, you will again need your username and password. After that, you should be good to go.

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### **Q. How can I find out whether I am a member of the C&T Section?**

A. You can find out if you're a C&T section member by logging into your MyBar page at [TexasBar.com](http://TexasBar.com). To log on to your My Bar page, your username is your State Bar number and your password is whatever you have chosen. If you have forgotten your password, you can reset it from your MyBar page. While you are at your My Bar page, be sure your email address is shown as your primary contact in your State Bar profile.

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**Q. How can I join the Computer & Technology Section so I can get access to the App?**

A. You can join the Computer & Technology Section with a credit card from your My Bar page at [TexasBar.com](http://TexasBar.com).

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**Q. I am a member of the Computer & Technology Section, but I don't have a tablet or smartphone. Is there any way I can access the App?**

A. If you don't have an iOS device or Android device, you can always use our web app. (It works on everything, including desktop computers.) Go here: <http://www.webapp.sbot.org>

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**Q. I updated the app and now I am no longer able to access it.**

A. Try uninstalling the App, rebooting your device, and reinstalling the App. When you're done with the reinstall, you may wish to turn off your device, wait 30 seconds, then turn it back on again. (That's usually a good idea when you install a new app or make a major update to an existing app.)

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**Q. I can't find the C&T Section App in the Apple App Store/Google Play Store.**

A. Search on "Texas Bar Legal."

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**Q. Please send me my username and password/I have lost my username and password/I have forgotten my username and password.**

A. Your username is your state bar number and your password is the self-selected password that you use to log in to your MyBar page on [Texasbar.com](http://Texasbar.com) and that you used to log in to sbot.org. If you have forgotten your password, you can reset it from your MyBar login page. While you are at your MyBar page, be sure your email address is shown as your primary contact in your State Bar profile.

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**Q. I am a member of the C&T Section and I have logged in at [sbot.org](http://sbot.org). I used the MyBar page credentials to log in to the App but I get a login failure notice. Please advise.**

A. If you are using an ipad or iphone, do the following:

1. Make sure you have updated the latest version of the App (AppStore<Updates);
  2. Clear Cache (Settings<Safari<Clear History and Clear Cookies and Data);
  3. Login again at your account at [www.texasbar.com](http://www.texasbar.com) (if you're able and you may or may not be, choose your email as your preferred contact of choice);
  4. Try App with the same username and password for 3, above;
  5. If not working, Login again at [www.sbot.org](http://www.sbot.org) in upper right corner; and
  6. Re-attempt App with [texasbar.com](http://texasbar.com) username and password.
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**Q. Why isn't the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure included in the Texas Legal App?**

A. We wish we could include the CCP. The Texas Criminal Defense Lawyers Association has the exclusive rights to that with the development company we use.

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**Q. I am unable to log in/I am a member of the C&T Section and I have logged in to [sbot.org](http://sbot.org). I tried to log in to the App using my State Bar number as my username and the password that I used to log in to [sbot.org](http://sbot.org) and to log in to my MyBar page on [Texasbar.com](http://Texasbar.com). They don't work.**
